The Lebanon County Prison Board was called to order at 11:30 a.m. by Commissioner Kuhn.

It was moved by Commissioner Phillips, seconded Commissioner Litz, to approve the minutes of the November 20, 2024 meeting.

Warden Tina Litz recognized the retirement of Captain Daniel J. Waltz. Captain Waltz served various roles throughout his 27 years of service with the County Correctional Facility, including serving as a Special Emergency Response Team (SERT) Commander.

CEO Tom Weber, PrimeCare Medical, gave a Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) Program update with currently 25 individuals on the maintenance program and 8 individuals detoxed. Weber said it is wise that Lebanon County is instituting the MAT program as other Counties are receiving letters threatening legal action. Tom Weber noted that some medical numbers are down because the prison population is also down.

Warden Tina Litz gave a brief update on staffing at the Correctional Facility. The LCCF has received several new applicants and hopes to have 10 new hires start in the Correctional Academy.

Tina Litz, Warden, submitted written reports of her activities for the month of November 2024. The Board reviewed this report.

Tina Litz, Warden, reported the average daily inmate population for November was 277.07. The Board reviewed this report.

Written reports on the commissary and the canteen were submitted by Rebekah Bowsman, Fiscal Technician. The commissary average weekly sales for a three (3) week operating period, during the month of November 2024 were \$3,451.64. The commission amount from October was \$6,655.08.

Heather Diehl, Deputy Warden of Operations, submitted a written report for the month of November 2024. The Board reviewed this report.

Rebecca Davis, Deputy Warden of Treatment, submitted a written report for the month of November 2024. The Board reviewed this report.

Capt. Daniel Waltz, Director of Security, submitted a written report giving his activities for the month of November 2024. The Board reviewed this report.

Edward Potter, Director of Training, submitted a written report giving his activities for the month of November 2024. The Board reviewed this report.

Stephanie Warner, Teacher from Lancaster-Lebanon Intermediate IU13, submitted a written monthly report on the High School Age Education Program for November 2024. 


