The Lebanon County Prison Board was called to order at 11:30 a.m. by Commissioner Kuhn.

The Lebanon County Commissioners convened today, all members present. Commissioner Kuhn presiding.

Warden Litz recognized Training Director, Edward Potter Jr, with a certificate of appreciation of sincere gratitude for assisting with Narcan to avoid an overdose to an incarcerated individual at the facility.

Deputy Warden of Treatment, Rebecca Davis, reported that there were two recent GED graduates at the Lebanon County Correctional Facility.

CEO Tom Weber, PrimeCare Medical, gave a statistical report for 2024 as follows:

1403 initial Intake Screenings (typically take 20-45 minutes to complete)

6066 Medical Sick Calls (approximately 17 a day for 365 days)

5875 Mental Health Sick Calls (approximately 23 a day for 261 days)

Approximately 68% of the facility population are MHSR C & D raters

Approximately 55% of the facility population received psychotropic medication

Approximately 64% of the facility population received medical medication

437 patients received MAT/MOUD treatment for opioid use disorder

158 patients were detoxed for opioid use, bringing the total of potential MAT/MOUD participants for the year to 595.

Tina Litz, Warden, submitted written reports of her activities for the month of December 2024. The Board reviewed this report.

Tina Litz, Warden, reported the average daily inmate population for December was 268.74. The Board reviewed this report.

Written reports on the commissary and the canteen were submitted by Rebekah Bowsman, Fiscal Technician. The commissary average weekly sales for a four (4) week operating period, during the month of December 2024 were \$3,488.26, commission amount from November was \$3,874.39.

Heather Diehl, Deputy Warden of Operations, submitted written reports of her activities for the month of December 2024. The Board reviewed this report.

Rebecca Davis, Deputy Warden of Treatment, submitted a written report for the month of December 2024. The Board reviewed this report.

Edward Potter, Director of Training, submitted a written report giving his activities for the month of December 2024. The Board reviewed this report.

Robert Gibson, Detail Officer, submitted a written report. The Detail Section worked a total of 1,650 hours during the month of December 2024. The Board reviewed this report.

Sgt. Edward Bartashus, Kitchen Sergeant, submitted a written report for the month of December 2024 giving a breakdown of cost of meals served and items donated.

Ray Arnold, Director of Work Release, submitted a written report for the month of December 2024. Mr. Arnold reported that there are 11 inmates employed within the community on the work release program and 3 inmates seeking employment. A total of 12 travel passes were issued during this period. The Board reviewed this report.

Rev. Marilyn Nolte, Chaplain Manager, submitted a written Chaplain's report for the month of December 2024. The Board reviewed this report.

A 2024 Statistical Summary Report from PrimeCare Medical was submitted.

CGL, submitted a written building maintenance report for the month of December 2024. CGL completed two hundred and eighty-nine (289) work orders during this period. The Board reviewed this report.

Stephanie Warner, Teacher from Lancaster-Lebanon Intermediate IU13, submitted a written monthly report on the High School Age Education Program for December 2024. The total students enrolled in the Emotional Support (E.S.) Program was zero (0) and the Alternative Education Program was two (2) students. The Board reviewed this report.

Ken Travis, High School Equivalency Instructor from Lancaster-Lebanon Intermediate IU13, submitted a written monthly report on the Community Education Program for December 2024. Total sessions to prepare students for the HiSET exams was (15) fifteen, nine (9) HiSet Exams completed by LCCF students, two (2) LCCF Students earning their High School Equivalencies, and five (5) request slips were received. Please allow this memorandum to serve as the written summary of the verbal statistical report I gave at last week's Prison Board meeting.¹

In 2024 for the Health Care Department completed:

1403 Initial Intake Screenings. (these typically take 30-45 minutes to complete)

6066 Medical Sick Calls (approximately 17 a day for 365 days)

5875 Mental Health Sick Calls (approximately23 a day for 261 days)

Approximately 68% on average of the facility population are MHSR C & D raters

Approximately 55% on average of the facility population received psychotropic medication.

Approximately 64% on average of the facility population was received medical medication.

437 patients received MAT/MOUD treatment for opioid use disorder.

158 patients were detoxed for opioid use. This brings the total of potential MAT/MOUD participants for the year to 595.

¹ Three of the data points differ slightly from those presented due to year-end finalization of the numbers. None of the variations are material in my opinion.

Nursing staff completes 9 medication passes every day of the year – 4 diabetic passes, 4 medical/psychotropic passes and I MAT/MOUD pass.

Attached hereto is our statistical summary for the year. This summary contains a lot more information detailing the efforts of the health care department throughout the year.

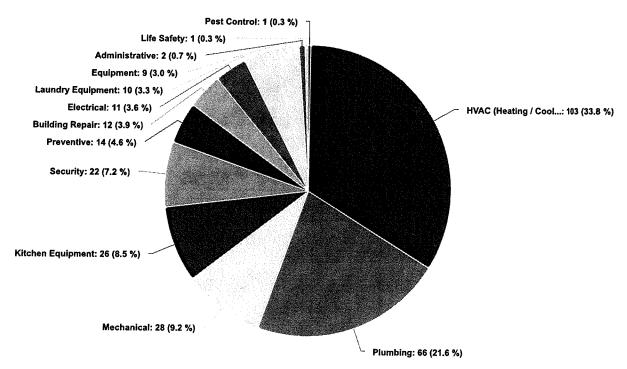

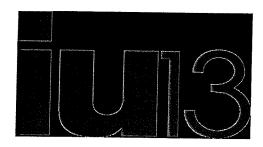
